Ölüdeniz

Ölüdeniz is arguably the most visited tourist location in Turkey and certainly the most photographed and an area of outstanding beauty.



Ölüdeniz is surrounded by tall mountains thick with pine forests leading down to a long sandy beach stretching to the lagoon in which all tones of green, blue and violet can be seen.

More recently Ölüdeniz has become more a centre for the spectacular sport of Paragliding. Taking off for the Mount of Babadag, 1975m above sea level, is a great way to appreciate the stunning scenery.

At the shores edge there are numerous cafés, restaurants and bars to relax and watch the world go by.

You can comfortably swim in the bay 10 months of the year and showers and changing facilities are also provided.

Ölüdeniz is reached on the regular dolmuş service running throughout the day and in to the midnight during the summer months.

12 Islands

Named by the fishermen as "Inside the darkness", the 12 Islands are composed of islands and the Kapıdağ peninsula, adorned with numerous bays, each one more beautiful than the other.

One of the regions most attractive areas to visit 12 Islands can be reached via daily boat trips from Fethiye.
