Fethiye

Set on the hillside of Mount Mendos, Fethiye is a vibrant harbour town sitting on the coast of the Mediterranean Sea.



The waters are the clearest turquoise shade and offer you the chance to watch the most glorious sun sets whilst sipping cocktails on the water's edge at one of the many bars and restaurants that surround the bay.

The town of Fethiye has everything you need for a rich and varied living experience – a wealth of historical and cultural sights, the bazaar with its narrow, shady streets, great shopping and outstanding beaches. Sailing is also very popular in Fethiye and offers a wide range of boat trips to the small islands lying off the coast or you can charter your own Gullet either with or without a crew.

Çalış Beach

Çalış beach is the best place to watch the sun go down, with 4 km. of beach and cool evening winds during the hot summer months. During the day the warm seas are perfect for a host of water sports, while in the evening, there are numerous restaurants and bars for you enjoy the end to a perfect day.

Dalaman – 50 km from Fethiye

Eating out:

There is a wide selection of restaurants around the harbour and in the town of Fethiye. In particular, we recommend the fish market in centre of Fethiye. The fresh catch is sold in the middle of a shady courtyard surround by friendly restaurants willing the cook your selection for about £2. A meal for 4 people including local wine will cost around £30.

Getting around:

The dolmus(local bus service) runs frequently, is widely available and is very cheap. As an alternative, there is also a water taxi between Çalış to the harbour of Fethiye.
